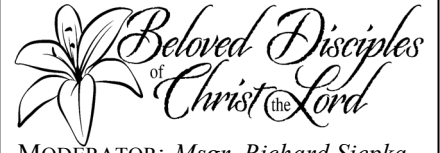

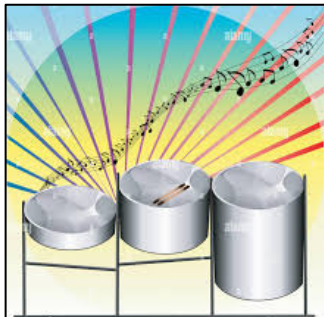
OUTDOOR PUBLIC ROSARY
