Road to Renewal Update

On June 13th, 13 of the 30 Catholic Churches in the Eastern and Southern suburbs in Erie County were recommended to close. These recommendations are based on various points of information studied by the Road to Renewal committee and focused on parish finances, demographics, sacraments, and information from the Disciple Makers Survey.

The recommendations for our Family are as follows: 1. St. Teresa of Calcutta to merge with St. Mary's and the property be sold.

- 2. Our Lady of Pompeii to merge with St. Mary's and remain as a secondary worship site.
- 3. St. Martha Parish to merge with St. Philip the Apostle and close. OLBS school will remain open for a period to be determined.
 - 4. Sacred Heart in Bowmansville to merge with Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Harris Hill. Chesterton Academy will continue as deemed appropriate. Sacred Heart will leave the Beloved Disciples of Christ the Lord Family.
 - 5. St. John the Baptist in Alden to join our Family.

It is estimated that in seven years we will have three priests to serve our Family and the Diocese believes that these recommendations are a strategic decision to make the Family more manageable for the priestly leadership.

The Family Council will meet to review and discuss the proposed recommendations and consider what, if any, counterproposals should be considered. All merger and closure decisions will be finalized by September 1st. Remember that these are merely recommendations at this time.

We realize that the recommendations are very painful and emotional for many of us. In the interim it is important that we do not lose faith, but rather have trust and pray that we are the right path to create a stronger and more vibrant Catholic Church for generations to come.
