Let us come together to honor God & His gift of life!

## BDCL COMMUNAL ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The parishes of the *Beloved Disciples of Christ the Lord* will be celebrating a mass for the Communal Anointing of the Sick at St. Martha



Parish on **THURSDAY**, **OCTOBER 10<sup>TH</sup> at 6:00PM** in the church. In order to receive this sacrament one does not have to be in imminent danger of dying. It may be received by those who are seriously ill, those facing surgery, the elderly, even sickly children who understand the meaning of the sacrament. Those individuals who are to be anointed should check in at one of the entrances to the church, where they will be given a name tag and directed where to sit. Family members may sit with the person to be anointed. People will be seated every other pew in order to give Fr. Bart and the other priests room to come to every person to be anointed. Communion will also be distributed to every individual in their pew. You do not need to register for this special mass but if you have any questions, please call the St. Martha Rectory at 716-684-6342.
