


BDCL ANNOUNCEMENT

This past Monday, September 9th, after two months of discussion and wide consultation within the Diocese, the final decisions for mergers in the Road to Renewal process were announced. Many of the original recommendations were reconsidered and some changes were made to better serve the future needs of the Church.

St. Martha Parish is recommended to be closed as a worship site and merge with St. Mary of the Assumption Parish, although Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament School will continue on the campus for the time being. It will be discussed as to what portions of the campus may be sold as well. Our Lady of Pompeii is scheduled to become a secondary worship site and merge with St. Mary of the Assumption Parish. St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta Parish will also merge into St. Mary of the Assumption Parish, but their property will be closed and sold. Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish in Bowmansville will leave our Family and join Family 15 in Clarence and Williamsville. St. Philip the Apostle Parish will remain open. Also, we will be welcoming St. John the Baptist Parish in Alden into the Beloved Disciples of Christ the Lord Family.

We will be forming Transition Teams at each Parish experiencing merger to discuss details and help determine the best way to commemorate the Parishes and celebrate the long tradition of those places forced to close. As we navigate through this difficult time of transformation in our Diocese, the clergy of our Family and all the members of our Family Council extend their heartfelt empathy and support for each of you. The decisions that have been made are not easy and can stir up a range of emotions, from sadness, to anger, to uncertainty. It's important to acknowledge these feelings and remember that change, while challenging, often brings new opportunities for growth and unity. Only together can we grow and build a stronger, more unified community of faith, grounded in our shared values and mission. No one is happy about the need to close Parishes, but the current financial state of our Diocese and ever-increasing fewer numbers of priests to serve our Parishes has forced us to make these radical changes to allow

the rest of the Church to grow and continue its mission of spreading the Gospel. We are with you in tears and in prayer. It is the hope of all involved that we will be able to work together to form a vibrant future for the Church in our communities.
